

Usage Guidelines

Ensure safety practices and exercise due care whilst using the equipment assigned under their responsibility.

No food, drink or chewing gum allowed

Respect time frame assigned.

All theatrical props and or post production equipment needs to be removed next day.

Nothing should be glued, taped or attached to any existing surfaces inside or outside the auditorium including chair and flooring. Decoration of any kind must be approved by the NAC Management

For risk and safety purposes, no extra chairs or tables are to be added inside the theatre.

The theatre is equipped with audio-visual capabilities and if you wish to utilize the equipment, a technician from the Council will be made available to operate the equipment. Any private audio-visual systems to be used in the theatre should be discussed with a technician well in advance.

Any damage caused by theatre assets will be the sole responsibility of the renter.

The Council will not be responsible for any loss of private property, personal or otherwise anywhere on the premises.

We will *not* provide;

- Security
- Parking Space
- Tables and chairs
- Extra lighting or extension cords not included in the agreement

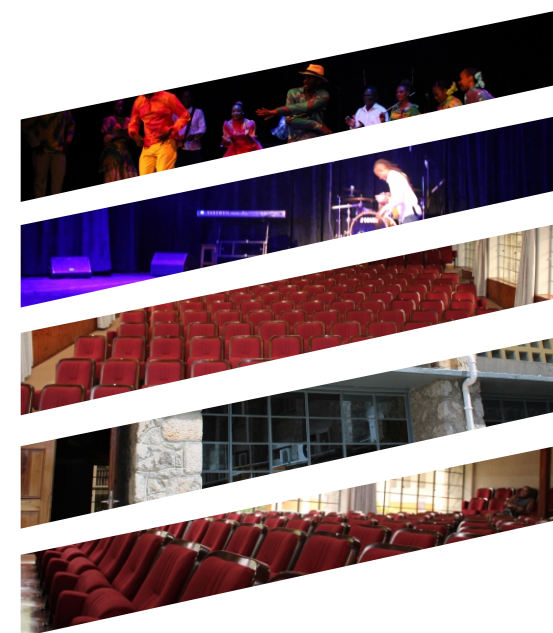

About the National Theatre

The National Theatre has reopened its doors to the artists and general public as of October, 2021. It is a facility under the purview of the National Arts Council of Seychelles (NAC) with the objective of developing arts in the country.

The National Theatre has a total of one hundred and sixty five (165) seats.

Mission

To stage, display and showcase artworks which are entertaining, challenging and inspiring, for the general public, to promote public appreciation and development of all art forms.

Objectives

To continue the tradition of the National Theatre of Seychelles as being the venue for artistic renditions with the aim of educating and building interest in the higher aspects of art.

To promote and encourage the staging, production and performance of different art forms to the highest standards.



Booking the Theatre

Operating Time

The National Theatre will be operational as of Monday to Saturday.

Operational: Mondays – Saturdays

Closed: Sundays

Exception is given to National events

Booking Fees

Any forms of artistic events inclusive of two (2) free rehearsals for half day is SCR 3,500.

Other events such as meetings and conferences is SCR2, 000.

Special rate for schools: SCR 200 per hour.

Rehearsals – SCR300 per hour.

Cancellation fee of 50% will be charged if booking is cancelled seven (7) days prior to the event date.

Awardees, registered members and Association Members will be eligible for a discounted fee of 10% on each bookings made.
